NNSA's Public Reading Facility Moves to New Location

Beginning Monday, June 9, the National Nuclear Security Administration Nevada Site Office's Public Reading Facility and Coordination and Information Center, now known as the Nuclear Testing Archive, will move to a new location at 755 East Flamingo Road, Las Vegas. Computer information will be continuously available during the move, but requests for the production of documents will be delayed until the move is complete. The expected date of completion for the move is June 30.

The Nuclear Testing Archive is a collection of historical documents, records, and data dealing with the United States nuclear weapons testing program. Bibliographic information from the Archive collection can be accessed through OpenNet at <http://www.osti.gov/opennet/>. OpenNet is the U.S. Department of Energy's bibliographic database containing declassified and publicly available documents. It is an automated searchable database which enables the interested stakeholder to identify documents of interest, determine their location within the Energy Department complex, and obtain ordering information.
