

Emergency Preparedness Working Group (EPWG) Grant

- Nevada Site Office funds the EPWG grant based on \$.50 per cubic foot of low-level/mixed low-level waste disposed at the Nevada National Security Site
- EPWG consists of six Nevada counties: Clark, Elko, Esmeralda, Lincoln, Nye, and White Pine
- EPWG addresses grant administration issues and any cross-cutting emergency related questions that incorporate grant funding or are required to attain operations level emergency response capability
- Priorities for grant funding include consideration for the needs of a county and the resource base available in that county
- State of Nevada Division of Emergency Management is responsible for financial administration of the grant. Funding is provided to the counties in accordance with approved grant application and oversight of funding use
