**Nevada National Security Site (NNSS)  
Prohibited Items  
(as of February 9, 2011)**

The following items/personnel are **prohibited** within the boundaries of the Nevada National Security Site:

- **NON-DRIVING PERSONNEL** (team drivers acceptable in delivery vehicles)
- **PETS** (police canine and service animals acceptable)
- **CHEMICAL IRRITANTS** (including mace and pepper spray in excess of two [2] fluid ounces)
- **AMMUNITION, EXPLOSIVES & INCENDIARY DEVICES** (road flares are acceptable)
- **WEAPONS** (including firearms, bows, knives with blades in excess of three inches in length, pellet or stun guns, etc. or any instrument or material likely to produce substantial injury to persons or damage to persons or property)
- **BINOCULARS/OPTICAL INSTRUMENTS**
- **CAMERAS/CAMCORDERS** (cell phone cameras may be carried in but may not be used)
- **AUDIO RECORDING DEVICES** (may be carried in but may not be used without authorization by NSO special permit)
- **RADIO FREQUENCY TRANSMITTING EQUIPMENT** (may be carried in but must be turned off)
- **NON-PRESCRIPTION CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES**
- **OPEN CONTAINERS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**
- **ANY OTHER ITEMS PROHIBITED BY LAW**

**NOTE: Bluetooth, computers, computer peripherals and cell phones with cameras are restricted in certain areas. NO personal property may be connected to government resources. All vehicles and cell phones (including stored files) are subject to search. All truck compartments and sleeper cabs will be searched.**
