NNSA's Public Reading Facility Moves to New Location

Bibliographic information from the CIC collection can be accessed through OpenNet <http://www.osti.gov/opennet/>. OpenNet is the U.S. Department of Energy's bibliographic database containing declassified and publicly available documents. It is an automated searchable database which enables the interested stakeholder to identify documents of interest, determine their location within the Energy Department complex, and obtain ordering information.
