U.S. Department of Energy Advisory Board Is Conducting Its 2012 Membership Recruitment Drive

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is currently accepting applications for membership on its community-based advisory board. The Nevada Site Specific Advisory Board (NSSAB) is comprised of rural and urban southern Nevada residents who provide recommendations to the U.S. Department of Energy Environmental Management Program regarding environmental clean-up activities at the Nevada National Security Site (formerly known as the Nevada Test Site).

NSSAB members meet as often as once a month and provide recommendations from a community perspective on radioactive waste management/disposal and transportation activities, the effects of historic nuclear testing on the groundwater at the Nevada National Security Site, and other environmental remediation activities.

“It’s very rewarding to be part of the advisory board by helping improve clean-up activities at the Nevada National Security Site through recommendations to the DOE,” said Kathleen Bienenstein, chair of the NSSAB.
