Hard Buried Targets Test Beds


- Multiple facilities, each of which can be configured to meet national security testing needs, including sensor development, targeting, characterization, and defeat
- Weapons experiments for combat applications

Sensor Programs

- Improvised explosive device detect, identify, and defeat technologies
- Determine signatures of homemade explosives production in a realistic setting

Radiological/Nuclear Test Beds

- Evaluate critical technologies for use in securing the United States against the smuggling of radiological and nuclear threats
