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Nevada Site Office to Hold Small Business Mentoring/Teaming Workshop

The National Nuclear Security Administration Nevada Site Office (NNSA/NSO) will hold a Pre-Submittal of Statements of Capability Conference and Small Business Mentoring/Teaming Workshop from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., February 19, 2003 at its North Las Vegas facility. The purpose of this conference and workshop is to provide a forum for small businesses to discuss the complexities of the requirements associated with an upcoming Security Protective Force Services contract solicitation. NNSA/NSO officials will also answer written questions and provide interested small businesses an opportunity to network with other businesses, both large and small, as potential team members.

Small and large businesses interested in attending are limited to a maximum of three (3) representatives, all of which must be U.S. citizens, and pre-registration is mandatory due to increased security requirements at federal facilities. To register, each attendee must fill out the attached form "Information Required from Uncleared U.S. Citizens for Access to U.S. Department of Energy, Nevada Operations Office Facilities," and fax the form to Wanda Gay, Contract Specialist, at (702) 657-7590 no later than Thursday, February 13, 2003. All attendees are requested to arrive 1 hour prior to the start of the workshop and should be prepared to have their vehicles searched. Individuals who do not pre-register will be denied access to the facility.
